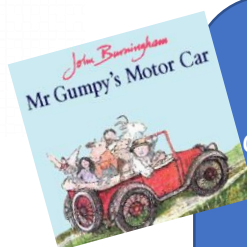

In Nursery the children have been exploring the book 'Whatever Next'.

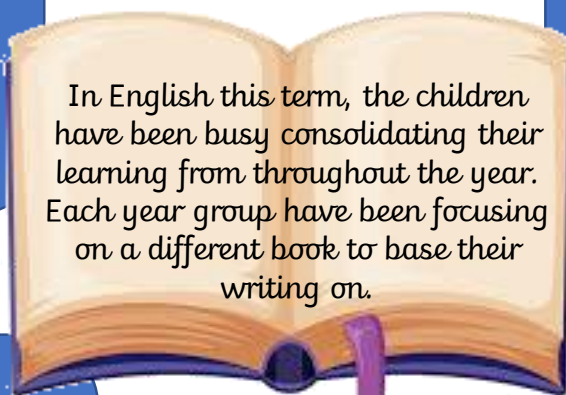
They have been exploring rhyming words and words that start with the same initial sound.

In Year 2 the children have been reading the book 'Zog'. They will be using the skills they have learnt this year to write a diary entry.

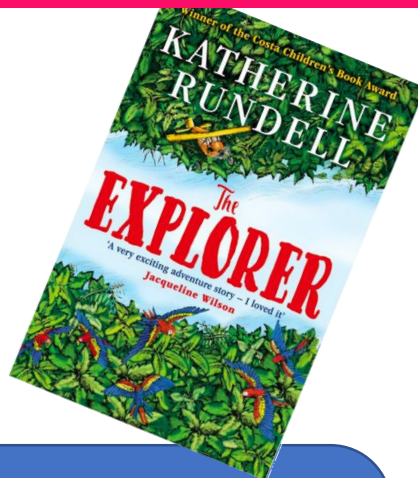

Year 3 have been looking at the text 'The King Who Banned the Dark' and will be writing diaries and a narrative about the book.



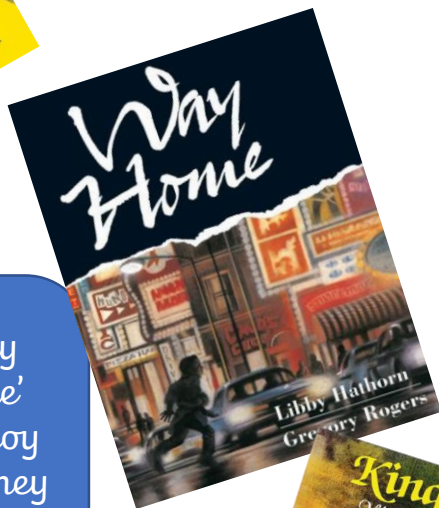
Year 3
