Early years have been learning about habitats, Year 1 have been learning about animals and plants.

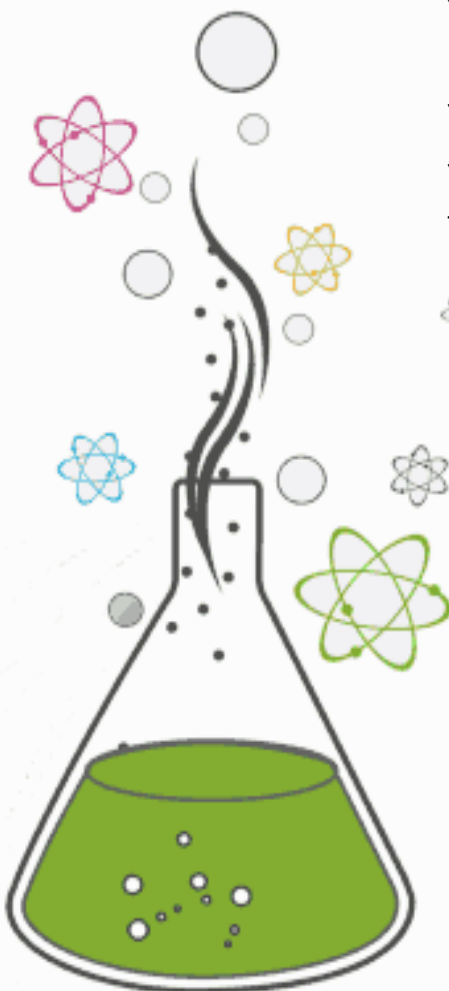
Year 2 have been learning about living things and their habitats and being healthy.

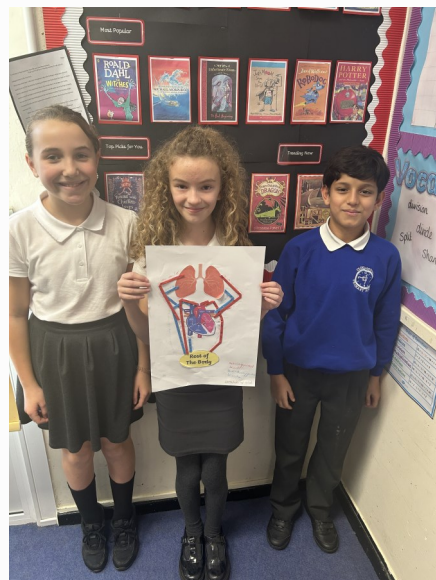
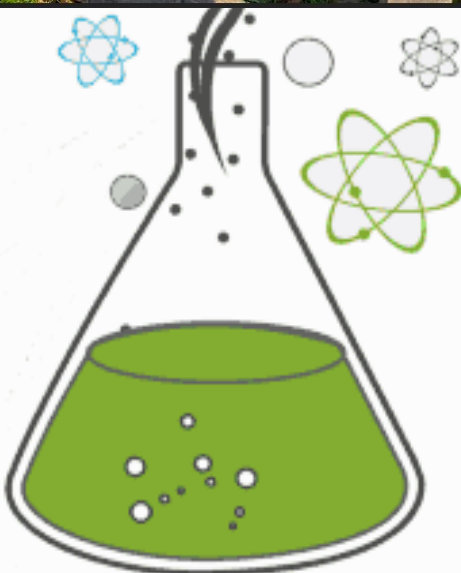
