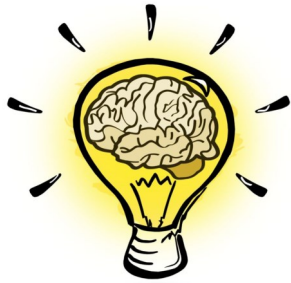

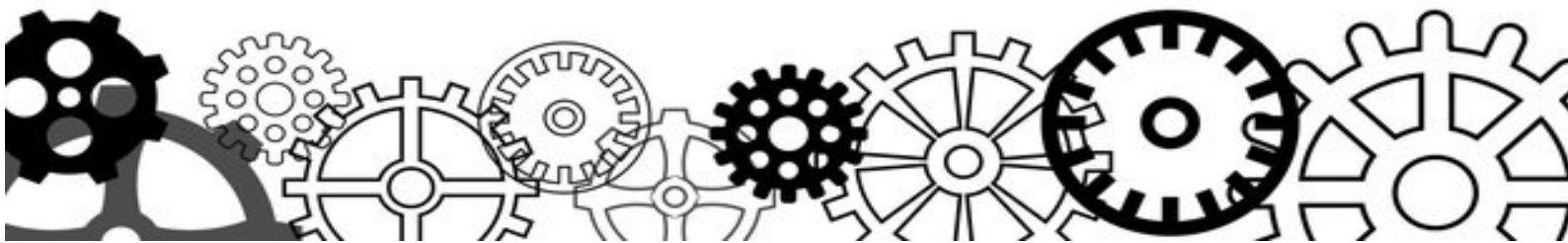
Clockhouse

I learnt how sew using different stitches: running, whip and back stitch. - Year 3

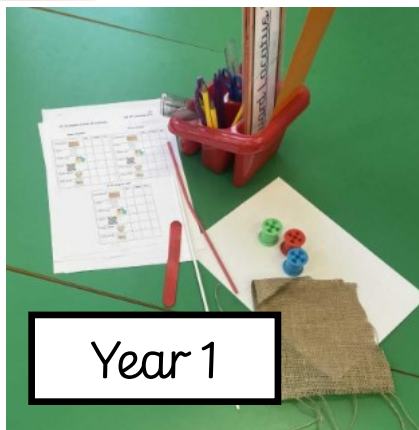
We are learning about shell structures and this will help us create our desk tidy. We have a design brief we must follow. -Year 4

We learnt how to code a digital thermometer for a pet using our new Micro: bit mini computers - Year 5

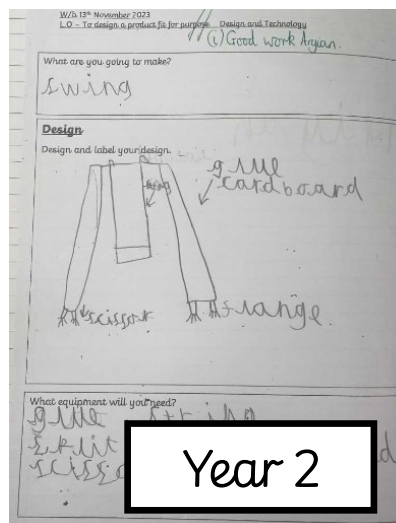
We love DT! We learnt all about circuits and fairground rides. We used our maths, science and DT skills to create our own moving fairground ride. —Year 6



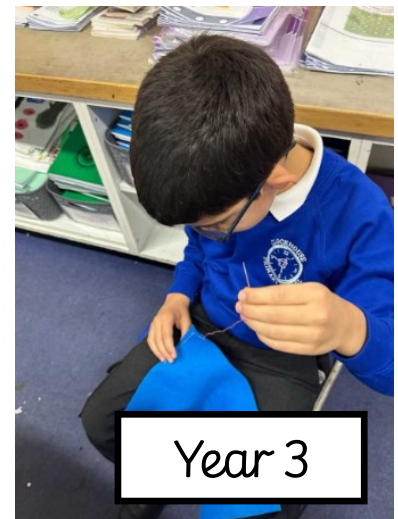

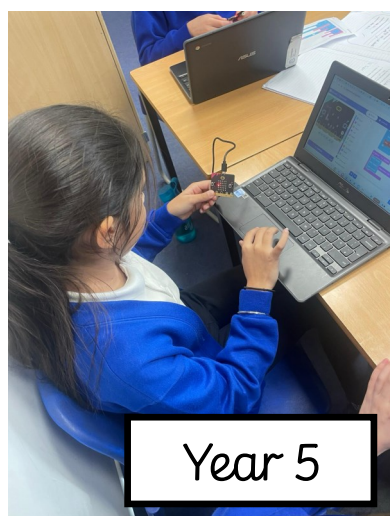
